# NATIONAL CONFEDERATION OF BANK EMPLOYEES ANDHRA PRADESH STATE FEDERATION STATE GENERAL COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 23.06.2019

We are extremely happy to inform that the State General Council Meeting of National Confederation of Bank Employees, Andhra Pradesh State Federation was held on 23.06.2019, as scheduled, in TSRTC Kala Bhavan, Hyderabad, a grand gala event, and was a TOTAL SUCCESS.

The State General Council was held for the first time after bifurcation of the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh State into Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States. The State General Council which was hosted by State Bank of India Staff Union Hyderabad Circle was attended by more than 2,000 comrades from different parts of both Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States.

The participation of Chief General Managers of Amaravati and Hyderabad Circles of State Bank of India in the conference, which was inaugurated by Com. Sanjeev K Bandlish, General Secretary of National Confederation of Bank Employees and All India State Bank of India Staff Federation, and the participation of galaxy of leaders from Trade Union fraternity made the conference a unique one.

Com. M. Janardhana Chary, Chairman, Reception Committee welcomed all the dignitaries to the dais. Com. N. Radhakrishnan, Vice-President, NCBE A.P. State Federation presided over the Meeting.

In his inaugural address, Com. Sanjeev K Bandlish said that the bank employees and the banking industry on the whole got benefitted by the entry of non-political and independent trade union i.e., National Confederation of Bank Employees, which he said has been fighting for the benefits of the members by simultaneously taking care of the growth of banking industry. Com. Bandlish also conveyed that the present and future days are tough due to the adoption of the ill-fated financial and banking reforms by the Government. Com. Bandlish further expressed that NCBE would strive hard to protect the public sector character prevalent in the country, if warranted through sustained struggles. Com. Bandlish also informed members about the developments relating to wage revision and appealed to all comrades to be in readiness for agitations, if any, at the call of NCBE.

Com. Mani Palvesan, Chief General Manger of State Bank of India, Amaravati Circle and Com. Om Prakash Mishra, Chief General Manager of State Bank of India Hyderabad Circle appreciated the pragmatic role of the organization in the areas of welfare of employees and growth of banking industry in the present day circumstances.

Com. S.C. Balaji, President of National Confederation of Bank Employees delivered Key Note Address, in which he has narrated the developments that took place in wage negotiations so far and informed that the wage revision is the priority as already nearly two years have elapsed since start of negotiations.

Com. M.V. Murali, former General Secretary of National Confederation of Bank Employees and All India State Bank of India Staff Federation conveyed that the hurdles and hiccups in the early conclusion of wage revision are not new and these persisted in all the earlier wage negotiations also. He also conveyed that the claims of IBA like inadequate paying capacity of banks, increasing losses, alarming increase in NPAs are the standard reasons told by IBA in all wage revisions. Com. Murali said that a better, reasonable and respectable wage revision can be achieved through sustained struggles alone.

Com. G. Subramanyam, Secretary, All India Bank Officers' Confederation, Telangana & Andhra Pradesh States conveyed his greetings and said that the co-ordination between AIBOC and NCBE is always strong both at the States' level as well as National level.

Com. V.V.S.R. Sarma, General Secretary, NCBE A.P. State Federation in his address spoke about the attacks on Public Sector Organizations of the country. He recalled the pivotal role played by the Public Sector Organisations in all the sectors for the country's economic development through decades and the way they are now being shown in poor light by the Governments/Corporates etc. He called upon the members to be in readiness to adopt agitation path, at the call of NCBE and UFBU and stand up to face the challenges confronting us in the days to come. Com. Sarma also cautioned that Officerisation, the order of the day, is not only detrimental to the working class of the country but also weaken the trade unions.

On the eve of retirement of Com. N. Radhakrishnan, President of the host Union and Vice-President, NCBE A.P. State Federation, he was felicitated by the host Union and all the leaders of NCBE and AISBISF present in the meeting. Com. Sarma praised the role of Com. N. Radhakrishnan for the excellent qualitative services rendered by him to all the leaders/organizations he was associated with throughout his trade union career. He on behalf of the entire membership of NCBE A.P. State Federation and State Bank of India Staff Union Hyderabad Circle wished Com. N. Radhakrishnan a happy, healthy and enriching retired life.

Responding to the felicitations, Com. Radhakrishnan thanked State Bank of India Staff Union Hyderabad Circle for providing opportunity to serve membership in different capacities. He thanked the leaders of SBISUHC, AISBISF and NCBE for the encouragement given to him and the felicitations on the occasion of his retirement.

In the Delegate Session that was held subsequent to the Inaugural Session of the Conference, the General Secretary presented his report covering the developments since last State General Council Meeting held in August 2011. He also presented the Statements of Accounts for the period covered under the General Secretary's Report. Later, the General Secretary placed the resolutions emanated out of the General Secretary's Report. The State General Council unanimously approved the General Secretary's Report, Statements of Accounts and Resolutions emanated from the report of General Secretary.

It was also decided in the State General Council to bifurcate the Andhra Pradesh State Federation into two viz., A.P. State Federation and Telangana State Federation. Accordingly, it was decided that a separate State Federation shall be created in respect of Telangana State.
